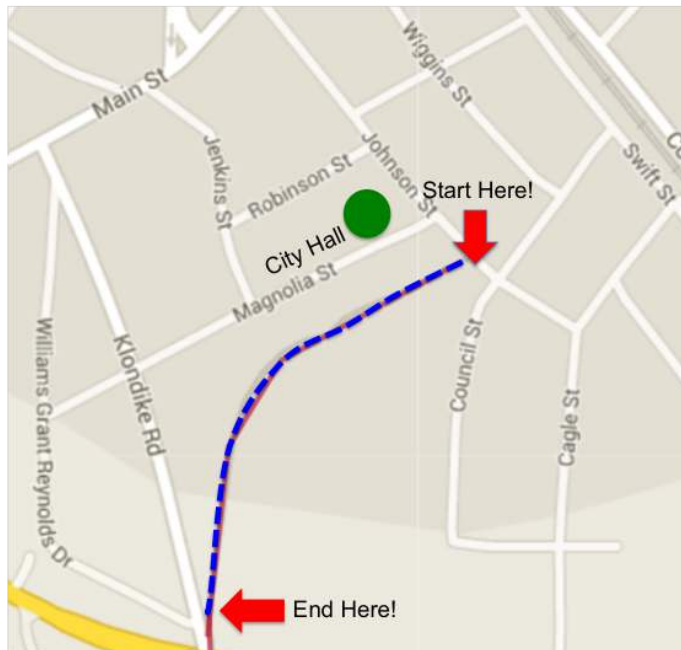

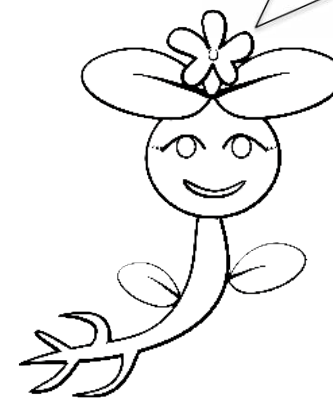

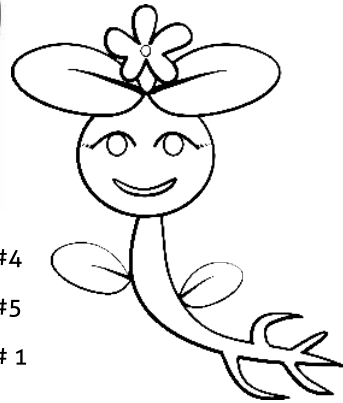
## Lithonia Scavenger Hunt

Complete the crossword puzzle. You'll find the answers during your adventure, then get your prize back at City Hall!

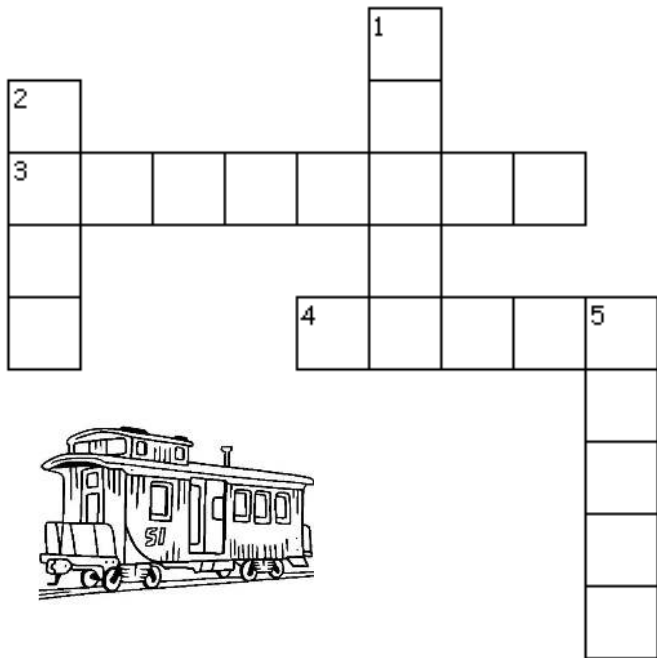


ACROSS:
