

# Biking at Arabia Mountain



To Stone Mountain  
8.8 Miles to entrance

To Atlanta  
17 Miles to 75/85

**Alexander Lakes : 4965 Flat Bridge Road SW**  
Offering striking views of Alexander Lakes and easy connections to the rest of Panola Mountain State Park, and the National Heritage Area, Alexander Lakes Trailhead is a welcoming place to start your ride.  
Note that parking is \$5.

**Stonecrest Library: 3123 Klondike Road**  
Park at the Stonecrest Library for a relatively easy start to your ride. Head south towards Arabia Mountain and Vaughters' Farm, or head north towards historic downtown Lithonia.

**Polebridge Trailhead: 6262 Browns Mill Road**  
One of the best trailheads for biking in the National Heritage Area. Easy access to the South River or downtown Lithonia, with plenty of room to give yourself as easy or as a difficult a ride as you'd want.

**Lorraine Trailhead: 3465 Hwy 138 SE**  
Offering scenic hillsides, striking views of the South River and beautiful forests, the Lorraine Trailhead is a great place to start your ride.

**Monastery Trailhead: 2625 Hwy 212 SW**  
Park at the Monastery and hop on some of the most dramatic trails in the National Heritage Area. Follow the PATH through scenic Honey Creek Woodlands and then north along the South River.
