

The Bruce Street School was DeKalb County's first public school for African American children. The schoolhouse was built in the 1930s, but the school's grassroots education goes back to the late 19th century. The old stone ruins that remain today stand as a testament to African American education in the Jim Crow South. The Arabia Alliance's Revitalization Project will turn this structure into a museum with an amphitheater, outdoor classroom, and more.
